Online membership renewals

Membership renewal is now complete. 21 members did not renew, and their membership has now expired. As I reported last month, the new process has been very successful and significantly reduced the time taken to complete the renewals process. The membermojo database also allows members to access and update their own information which is a requirement of the new General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) which come into force on May 25th.

Range Damage

The NRA Range Inspection to say that we needed to implement new rules about placing targets within the static frames also recommended that we put numbers on the target frame to coincide with the benches so as to avoid any cross shooting.

This work was completed on 16 April with small white boards with spray painted numbers stapled to the frame; and yet by our next Monday work party on 30 April we found that two of them had been deliberately shot with neat groups of .22 rounds.

So how are we to interpret deliberate shooting at things which are not targets and causing damage which others have to repair? The word vandalism springs to mind and seems quite appropriate. So please take note that we will not tolerate this either from members or affiliates and if anyone is caught doing same they can expect to say farewell to their club membership.
