

Running Deer Range

The general limitations on the Running Deer range are:

Calibre .577"

Muzzle Velocity 3275 ft/sec

Muzzle Energy 3320 ft lbs (4500 Joules)

Competition Rules do not permit the use of a calibre greater than 8.0 mm. The BSRC imposes the further limitation that the case capacity of any ammunition used must not exceed that of the .30-06 round. In addition, although within the range limits, the use of any .338 calibre is prohibited on all Bisley ranges due to the MoD requirement for a Range Danger Area (RDA) of 3700m; the RDA for the Running Deer range is 2900m. The .22-250 and the .220 Swift are banned from BSRC ranges due to the likelihood of exceeding the range muzzle velocity limitation.
